

**Guideline on Capital Adequacy Requirements  
(An Act respecting insurance, CQLR, c. A-32, sections 325.0.1 and 325.0.2)**

The AMF is publishing for consultation the draft revised *Guideline on Capital Adequacy Requirements*. This guideline is intended for property and casualty insurers licensed to transact insurance business in Québec and holding a charter issued by the province of Québec or by another Canadian jurisdiction. The changes mainly have for objective to harmonize the AMF's requirements to the suggested Canadian requirements. The changes are expected to come into effect on January 1, 2019.

Persons interested in submitting their comments are invited to provide them no later than August 10, 2018. It should be noted that comments submitted will be made public unless otherwise noted.
