

Guideline on Information and Communications Technology Risk Management – Extended consultation

(Act respecting insurance, CQLR, c. A-32, ss. 325.0.1 and 325.0.2)

(Act respecting financial services cooperatives, CQLR, c. C-67.3, ss. 565.1 and 566)

(Act respecting trust companies and savings companies, CQLR, c. S-29.01, s. 314.1)

The Autorité des marchés financiers (the “AMF”) is extending the consultation period for the draft *Guideline on Information and Communications Technology Risk Management*. The guideline is intended for life insurance companies, property insurance companies, holding companies controlled by an insurer, financial services cooperatives, trust companies and savings companies. The Guideline is expected to come into effect on June 1, 2019.

Persons interested in submitting their comments are invited to provide them no later than February 25, 2019. It should be noted that comments submitted will be made public unless otherwise noted.
