The Autorité des marchés financiers (the "AMF") is publishing for consultation the draft *Climate Risk Management Guideline* (the "Guideline") applicable to authorized insurers, financial services cooperatives, authorized trust companies and other authorized deposit institutions.

The expectations in the Guideline mainly concern:

- governance;
- integrated risk management;
- climate scenarios and stress testing;
- capital and liquidity adequacy;
- fair treatment of clients; and
- climate-related financial risk disclosures.

Interested persons must submit their comments by **January 30, 2024**. All comments will be made public unless the commenter requests otherwise.
