

Notice specifically for insurance and financial planning representatives, firms, independent representatives and independent partnerships subject to the *Act respecting the distribution of financial products and services* – COVID-19

The AMF continues to actively monitor the evolving situation with COVID-19 and is in frequent contact with stakeholders in Québec's financial sector. As part of its operational capacity assessment, the AMF today is announcing additional regulatory relief measures.

Certificate renewals

The AMF is extending the renewal deadline for certificates expiring on March 31 and April 30, 2020 to May 31, 2020 and June 30, 2020, respectively.

Representatives covered by this extension do not have to take any action to qualify for it. Their certificates will remain in effect. They will not receive a confirmation of extension from the AMF. They may personally confirm their continued right to practise at any time by checking the Register of firms and individuals authorized to practise.

Fee payment deferrals

Representatives wishing to defer the payment of fees for any applications they may have to submit to us may do so by contacting the AMF Information Centre, making a request and entering into an agreement with an agent.

Registered firms and independent partnerships may obtain a fee payment deferral for their applications by contacting the AMF Information Centre.
