

Notice specifically for money-services businesses registered with the AMF

The AMF continues to actively monitor the evolving situation with COVID-19 and is in frequent contact with the stakeholders in Québec's financial sector. As part of its operational capacity assessment, the AMF today is announcing additional regulatory relief measures.

Licence renewals

At the beginning of March, money-services businesses registered with the AMF received an invoice for the annual fees they are required to pay to maintain their operating licence. Businesses that are unable to pay the annual fees at this time may obtain a deferral agreement by contacting the AMF Information Centre

Licence applications

Money-services businesses that apply for a licence may also obtain a fee payment deferral by contacting the AMF Information Centre.

If the exceptional situation caused by COVID-19 continues, other regulatory relief measures and fee reductions will be considered.
