The consequential amendments made to:

- Regulation 13-101 respecting System for Electronic Document Analysis and Retrieval (SEDAR),
- Regulation 31-102 respecting National Registration Database,
- National Instrument 55-102, System for Electronic Disclosure by Insiders (SEDI), and

as published in Chapter 6 of the Bulletin of the Autorité des marchés financiers, July 2013, Volume 10, No. 28, contained errors. In fact, the SEDAR filing service contractor, SEDI operator and NRD administrator will change from CDS Inc. to the Alberta Securities Commission (the ASC). Upon completion of the transition of operation of SEDAR, SEDI and NRD from CDS Inc. to CGI Information Systems and Management Consultants Inc., the ASC will be the representative securities regulatory authority authorized to grant licenses and enter into agreements with users of SEDAR, SEDI and NRD on behalf of CSA members. The corrected versions of the amendments are being published in Chapter 6 of today's Bulletin.
